Welcome to the New Year!! Yes, I know we are already several days into the year, but this is our first newsletter for 2020. We trust that each of you had very blessed Christmas season. Ours was quiet but very enjoyable.

As the new year unfolds Helen and I are excited to see what God has in His plans for our ministry. Many of you know that in July of this year I will be stepping down as the Director of Rockies Southwest Bible Church Extension as our Director Designate, Tim Chally, will take the helm. Because of this transition taking place there has been a misunderstanding concerning Helen and me, and our continued missionary service with RSBCE. Let me state, I am not retiring! We will continue to serve the Lord as missionaries with RSBCE in church planting. I am referencing this simply because we have had several of our supporters and supporting churches ask this question. We covet your prayers, and as God would enable, your continued support as we step into new roles of ministry with RSBCE.

One of those potential roles is the start of a new church plant in LaJunta, Colorado. Last summer I was contacted by a group of believers in the LaJunta area that had visited one of our IFCA churches in Pueblo. Their contact with the pastor and staff at that church led them to contact RSBCE. We have been meeting together seeking the Lord’s direction about starting a Bible Church in the LaJunta area. Would you please pray with us about this opportunity to serve RSBCE in this new church plant?

Since early December we have been engaged with assisting South Routt Bible Church in Oak Creek, CO as this mission church is now without a missionary pastor. God has graciously provided good pulpit supply in this time of transition for this ministry as well. Pray that God will lead us, the mission and the church, to the missionary/pastor of His choosing for this vital work in the Yampa Valley.

I, Paul, want to thank you for your prayers for my recovery following the surgery last November to fuse my left ankle. The surgery went well and in follow up appointments the x-rays show the fusing taking place, but it is not complete at this time. I am scheduled to see the surgeon again on January 28<sup>th</sup> for another round of x-rays and evaluation. I am praying that at that time I will be able to begin therapy and start walking on the foot again. I am out of the cast but wearing a “supportive boot” but I am not to bear weight on the foot.

Helen is busy caring for her convalescing husband, caring for the home duties, teaching piano, as well as her secretarial work at the church and bookkeeping duties at the mission office. She deserves a special “star” or two in her crown!! What a complimentary companion and helpmate she has

There are some very urgent and important prayer requests that I would ask that you pray about.

1. Our Hispanic Missionary Family working in Green River, Utah - Jonatan and Grissel Gomez - need a vehicle. The van that they have been driving needs major repairs and perhaps replacement would be the better option. Would you pray that God would provide for this immediate and urgent need?

2. Stephen and Amanda Chapman, are seeking God's direction in their ministry. They have been asked by the mission to consider a couple of opportunities. Pray that God will guide, give wisdom, and clearly make known His leading.

The Chapman's also are facing the need for replacement of a vehicle or some major costly repairs. Pray that God will meet this need for this family.

3. As we begin the New Year, we are asking God to provide additional funding for the General Fund of RSBCE. This fund is the operational fund for the mission and was short this past year. Would you prayerfully consider making the General Fund part of your monthly giving to RSBCE?

4. Pray with us as we work with potential church plant in LaJunta. We believe God is opening the door and want to serve this need as fully as possible as a mission. Pray for a missionary family to become part of this new work.

5. Pray for the missionary/pastor need at South Routt Bible Church as we need to place a missionary on that field. Pray for the dear folks at South Routt Bible Church as they faithfully wait upon the Lord for a missionary pastor to serve the congregation.

We want to again "thank you" for your partnership in the work of RSBCE in prayer, financial support of the mission and missionaries, and ministry teams that have served our church plants. Our vision is to see Bible Churches planted and strengthened throughout the great Rockies/Southwest region of the United States. That God would be glorified through the establishment of churches where followers of Christ meet in worship, fellowship, prayer, and outreach with the gospel.

One of my favorite passages of Scripture is found in Paul's letter to the church at Philippi.

*"I thank my God upon every remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine making request for you all with joy for your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now, being confident of this very thing that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ..."* Philippians 1:3-6

It will be our joy to communicate with you throughout the year as that path unfolds and we see God's gracious hand continuing to meet our need, guide our steps, and use these vessels of clay for His eternal glory.
